The Purchaser must promptly, after clearance of full payment, remove the Goods from the Vendor's property and transport 17. them in a safe and proper manner and in accordance with all legal requirements, all entirely at the Purchaser's risk and expense. The Purchaser must comply with any reasonable directions given by the Vendor or its employees or agents. In removing the Assets, the Purchaser must not damage any of the Vendor's property. The Purchaser shall indemnify the Vendor against any damage, loss, liability, actions, claims costs or expenses which the Vendor may incur as a result of the failure of the Purchaser to fully comply with this clause.

The Purchaser shall pay all stamp duty, and other duties and texes which may be payable in respect of this agreement or sale or any documents in connection with them. The Purchaser indemnifies the Vendor against any loss or liability incurred or suffered by the Vendor as a result of the delay or failure by the Purchaser to pay any duties payable by the Purchaser pursuant 18.
